Its sake made from natural water that is pumped from 150 meters underground are refreshing and have a very mild taste. Please enjoy them at the venue.

It is a long established specialty store of the uchiwa, sensu and washi products that have been in existence for more than 400 years since the Edo period. It will sell products such as Edo sensu, which has a simple design and is extremely stylish, and Edo uchiwa, which is made by splitting a piece of bamboo.

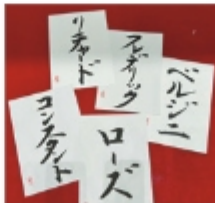
